

**AMENDED ORDINANCE 2013-02**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION AND PAY SCALE FOR TWO PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT POLICE DEPARTMENT AND RECONFIRMING THE POSITION OF POLICE CHIEF AND SERGEANT WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT POLICE DEPARTMENT.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor has recommended to Council that the position of two part time police officers be established within the Village of Commercial Point Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the two part time police positions are deemed necessary by Council to ensure the efficient administration of the Police Department of the Village of Commercial Point; and

**WHEREAS**, the establishment of a new position of employment within the Village requires enactment of legislation for the pay scales of newly-hired employees; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Commercial Point Police Department has a part time, thirty (30) hour per week, Police Chief and Council desires to continue that position; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Commercial Point Police Department has a part time, thirty (30) hour per week, Sergeant and Council desires to continue that position.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Village of Commercial Point, County of Pickaway, and State of Ohio as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The positions of two part time police officers are hereby established within the Village of Commercial Point Police Department.

**SECTION 2:** One part time police officer shall be hired for a maximum of thirty (30) hours per week at a compensation rate range of \$12.00 to \$14.00 per hour.

**SECTION 3:** One part time police officer shall be hired for a maximum of sixteen (16) hours per week at a compensation rate of \$12.00 per hour.

**SECTION 4:** The positions of part time Police Chief and part time Sergeant within the Village of Commercial Point Police Department shall be continued as currently staffed.

**SECTION 5:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 6:** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period permitted by law
