

ORDINANCE 2014-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WORKING HOURS FOR A PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has established a part time police officers position within the Village of Commercial Point Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Council has established a part time police officer position for a maximum of sixteen (16) hours per week at a compensation rate of \$12.00 per hour; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to increase the maximum working hours to provide the police department greater flexibility in scheduling police officers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Commercial Point, County of Pickaway, and State of Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: Part time police officer position, previously restricted to sixteen (16) hours, shall be increased to less than thirty (30) hours per week at a compensation rate of \$12.00 per hour.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period permitted by law

SECTION 4: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.




