

RESOLUTION 18-2014

A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND FROM THE TRANSFERS OUT ACCOUNT 1000-910-910 AND TRANSFER SAID MONIES TO THE POLICE ENFORCEMENT AND EDUCATION FUND 2271-931 TRANSFERS IN ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS, Council is authorized to create, appropriate, and transfer funds of the Village of Commercial Point; and

WHEREAS, monies were received from the Circleville Municipal Court for fines relating to OVI's received in the Village and deposited into the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code §4511.193 states these funds are to be used for Police Enforcement and Education; and

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2014 Village of Commercial Point Council approved the creation of the new fund.

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has calculated a total of \$ 1,100.00 to be transferred into the Police Enforcement and Education Fund to cover the monies deposited into the General Fund for these fines.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby approves the transfer of funds from the General Fund Transfers Out Account 1000-910-910 into the Police Enforcement and Education Fund Transfers In Account 2271-931.

Section 2. Monies in the amount of One thousand, one hundred dollars and no cents (\$1,100.00) shall hereby be transferred from the General Fund of the Village of Commercial Point from Account Number 1000-910-910 Transfers Out Account to Police Enforcement and Education Fund Account Number 2271-931 Transfers In Account.

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Commercial Point which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.




