

RESOLUTION 15-2011

A RESOLUTION INCREASING THE COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Village Council has determined that the compensation paid to the Mayor of the Village should be increased pursuant to the authority granted in Article XVIII, Sections 2 and 3 of the Constitution of the State of Ohio, to adequately compensate the Mayor for the performance of his or her duties.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION 1. The compensation paid to the Mayor of the Village of Commercial Point shall be increased from six thousand dollars (\$6,000) annually to fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) annually.

SECTION 2. The increase to the Mayor's compensation shall commence on January 1, 2012.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the Village of Commercial Point. Emergency passage is necessary in order to adequately compensate the Mayor of the Village for the performance of his or her duties and to ensure that the statutory requirements set forth in the Ohio Revised Code are complied with to ensure that the effective date for said increase shall be January 1, 2012. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period provided by law.
