

**RESOLUTION 06-2012 VOIDED – THIS ACTION WAS COMPLETED WITH ORDINANCE 2012-02**

**A RESOLUTION TO REALIGN MONIES WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND FROM THE TRANSFERS OUT FUND 1000-910-910 AND TRANSFER SAID MONIES TO THE CAPITAL OUTLAY POLICE DEPARTMENT FUND 1000-110-590.**

WHEREAS, Council is authorized to create, appropriate, and transfer funds within the General Fund of the Village of Commercial Point; and

WHEREAS, Emergency monies were used from the Capital Outlay Fund to repair the tornado siren; and

WHEREAS, Monies appropriated to the Transfers Out were more than needed; and

WHEREAS, Additional monies are needed to replace the money used from the Capital Outlay Fund.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1. Monies in the amount of Ten Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$10,100.00) shall hereby be transferred within the General Fund of the Village of Commercial Point from Account Number 1000-910-910 Transfers Out Fund to Account Number 1000-110-590 Capital Outlay Fund.

Section 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the Village of Commercial Point. Emergency passage is necessary in order to replace monies used from the Capital Outlay Fund for the Police Department. Therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
