

**RESOLUTION 15-2015**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND/OR MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT FOR THE SERVICE AND MAINTENANCE OF THE COPIER AT THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council has determined a need for service and maintenance of the copier at the Municipal Building; and

**WHEREAS**, MT Business Technologies, Inc. submitted a proposal (Exhibit A) to provide service and maintenance protection for the copier at the Municipal Building; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council desires to accept their proposal; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Administrator and/or Mayor is authorized to enter into contracts and agreements on behalf of the Village.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Commercial Point, Pickaway County, Ohio, a majority or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

**SECTION 1:** The Council of the Village of Commercial Point hereby authorizes and directs the Village Administrator to enter into a contract with MT Business Technologies, Inc. to provide service and maintenance of the Village's copier at the Municipal Building, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3:** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage. This emergency measure is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, and it is further reason that it is immediately necessary to participate in this maintenance contract in order to properly equip the Village for efficient operation and preservation of public funds.


