

RESOLUTION 26-2016

A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER MONIES WITHIN THE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT FUND FROM THE OTHER CONTRACTUAL SERVICES ACCOUNT 2901-490-399 AND TRANSFER SAID MONIES TO THE MEDICARE ACCOUNT 2901-710-213.

WHEREAS, Council is authorized to create, appropriate, and transfer funds within the Housing Development Fund of the Village of Commercial Point; and

WHEREAS, Council has agreed to create a Village Engineer position; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer position will be contributing to Medicare; and

WHEREAS, monies appropriated to the Other Contractual Services Account were more than needed; and

WHEREAS, monies appropriated to the Medicare Account were less than needed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1. Monies in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$ 150.00) shall hereby be transferred within the Housing Development Fund of the Village of Commercial Point from Account Number 2901-490-399 Other Contractual Services Account to Account Number 2901-710-213 Medicare.

Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Commercial Point which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
