## **RESOLUTION 11-2017**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND/OR MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT TO ENTER INTO AN EXTENTION OF A RIGHT OF ENTRY AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT FOR THE EXAMINING AND TESTING OF PROPERTY FOR WATER SERVICE CAPACITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined a need to explore the possibility of expanding its water service capacity; and

WHEREAS, on or about, August 1, 2016, the Village had entered into a Right of Entry Agreement with Trustee, Robert Hess, for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to extend that agreement to allow additional testing.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Commercial Point, Pickaway County, Ohio, a majority or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

**SECTION 1:** The Council of the Village of Commercial Point hereby authorizes and directs the Village Administrator and/or Mayor to enter into an extended Right of Entry Agreement on behalf of the Village to explore expanding the Village's water service capacity, copies of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

**SECTION 2:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3:** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after it passage. The Village is at near capacity for water services to ensure the health and welfare of the citizens' immediate exploration is needed.

the right of entry for the month of May 2017 an additional \$1,000.00 sum is owed to

Owner.

This extension shall be on all other terms and conditions as stated in the original

Agreement.

This extension Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the

parties, their successors, and personal representatives.
