

Resolution 09-2017

A RESOLUTION TO CREATE A CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL TRAINING FUND WITHIN THE 2017 PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS BUDGET FOR THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT AND DECLARE IT AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Commercial Point is required to deposit and distribute all monies received from the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission using a dedicated fund specifically for the purpose of education and training; and

WHEREAS, no dedicated fund for the purpose of receiving and distributing monies from the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission currently exist within the 2017 appropriations budget for the Village of Commercial Point.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, OHIO, that:

Section 1. The Fiscal Officer of the Village of Commercial Point shall create an Education and Training fund within the 2017 permanent appropriations budget.

Section 2. The Fiscal Officer of the Village of Commercial Point shall use this fund to deposit and distribute all monies received from Ohio Attorney General's Office, Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission in accordance with the guidelines for education and training.

Section 3. Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency for the reason that monies have been received from the Ohio Attorney General's office, Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission and deposited into the General Fund until this fund is created in accordance with the guidelines as set forth by the Ohio Revised Code.
