

**VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
October 19, 2015**

Mayor Hammond called the meeting to order (7:00pm). Council Member David Sadler took roll call with the following members present: Mr. Shelton, Mr. Wissinger Mr. Geiger and Mr. Sadler being present.

Mr. Geiger made a motion, seconded by Mr. Wiessenger to suspend the procedural rules. Mr. Shelton, Mr. Wissinger Mr. Geiger and Mr. Sadler being present voted in favor. The motion passed.

Mayor Hammond read title-only Resolution Resolution 21-2015 (A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER MONIES WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND FROM THE STREETS FUND 1000-620-399 AND TRANSFER SAID MONIES TO THE SIDEWALKS FUND 1000-670-396). David Sadler asked for an explanation and it was explained that \$48,000 was required for additional sidewalks that were not originally budgeted for. Motion by Randy Shelton and second by Mark Geiger to wave the (3) readings. Mr. Shelton, Mr. Wissinger Mr. Geiger and Mr. Sadler being present voted to wave (3) readings. Motion to adopt Resolution by Motion by Randy Shelton and second by Mark Geiger. Mr. Shelton, Mr. Wissinger Mr. Geiger and Mr. Sadler voted in favor or resolution.

Mayor Hammond read (1st Reading) title-only Ordinance 2015-12 (AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING COMMERCIAL POINT CODE SECTION 425.15 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES REGARDING PARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES, TRAILERS, RECREATIONAL VEHICLES AND BOATS). David Sadler asked for a background of the ordinance and who was making the request. Mayor Hammond advised that he was informed by a reputable citizen about Hill Jack Trucking planning to park their trucks in the Fox Fire subdivision. Ordinance was at Mayor Hammond's request to protect the citizens from abuse of parking trucks in front of their property. Council comments suggested ordinance was a bit excessive as written.

Clarence Wissenger made a motion, seconded by David Sadler to adjourn the meeting. All members present were in favor. The meeting adjourned.
